



Alta Baliza Sauvignon Blanc Central Valley, Chile Refreshing, young wine. The aromas are fresh with hints of grass & citrus fruit. On the palate, balanced acidity, light-bodied & lingering finish.	£8.00	£10.70	£29.00
Tanti Petali Catarratto Pinot Grigio Sicily, Italy Light & leafy with a hint of pear & blossom. An easygoing match for almost anything.	£8.30	£11.00	£30.00
Gravel & Loam Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough, New Zealand Intense gooseberry aromas alongside notes of fresh herbs & grassy tones. Vibrant passion fruit, citrus & peach flavours. Elegantly dry & refreshing.	£12.40	£16.50	£45.00
Azabache Blanco Rioja Rioja, Spain Crisp & aromatic with bright citrus, green apple, & subtle tropical notes. Fresh acidity lifts the palate, finishing clean with a gentle floral touch.	-	-	£40.00
Cuvee Prestige Picpoul De Pinet Picpoul De Pinet, France A dry white wine with a pale gold colour. A fine, fresh nose with fruity & floral aromas. A refreshing palate with hints of citrus.	-	-	£55.00
Alain Geoffroy Chablis Burgundy, France Fragrant flowers, fruity aromas with sweet, suave scents. A pronounced mineral character enhances the fruit flavours.	-	-	£70.00
Sancerre Domaine Neveu Loire Valley, France Classic wine from the historical home of Sauvignon. Not only does it have an elegant 'gunflint' minerality, but the grassy, gooseberry fruit carries through the citrus richness.	-	-	£70.00



Alta Baliza Merlot Central Valley, Chile Aromas of mature fruits, red berries & some spiced notes precede rich tannins with a medium body.	£8.00	£10.70	£29.00
Showdown Cabernet Sauvignon California, USA Ripe blackcurrant & wild berry fruit on the nose is complimented by sweet vanilla oak. Rich cassis & black cherry fruit on the palate is followed by a soft, juicy, yet long finish, framed by the subtle American oak.	£10.70	£14.30	£40.00
Oscuro Mendoza Malbec Mendoza, Argentina Pure, juicy flavours of plum & blackberry, with a hint of chocolate & vanilla from the oak ageing. It has a long, lingering & elegant finish.	£10.70	£14.30	£40.00
Esk Valley Pinot Noir Marlborough, New Zealand This is a robust & concentrated style of Marlborough Pinot Noir, grown on the clay soils of the Wairau Valley's southern hills. Exhibiting aromas & flavours of dark brambly fruits including cherry & plum with notes of herbs & spice. With it's subtle oak influence, this is a fruit forward style & a fine match with food.	-	-	£45.00
Chateau de Barbe Blanche Saint-Émilion Bordeaux, France Made using fruit from 30yr old vines atop one of the highest plateaus in St Emilion, the Merlot brings red fruit aromas & silkiness whereas the Cabernet Franc gives freshness & tannins. Barrel ageing softens the wine & its tannins to a velvety touch in the mouth, while bringing tantalising hints of oak to an already complex wine.	-	-	£60.00
Glorioso Gran Reserva Rioja Rioja, Spain Intense & elegant with notes of blueberries & red forest fruits. Due to its aging in French oak, delicate aromas of menthol & cedar appear with a mineral finish that gives it personality. It is dense, well balanced, with fine & polished tannins and a long finish.	-	-	£65.00
Gevrey - Chambertin Vallet Frères Burgundy, France Ripe red cherry & soft woodland notes with gentle spice, fine tannins & a smooth, elegant palate. Subtle earthiness & bright acidity, finesse & depth.	-	-	£135.00


